Update for Churches reopening.

"As many of you may be aware, an announcement by Premier Ford gives permission for church congregations in our area of the province to resume services, albeit with a limit of 30% church capacity. Additionally, the United Church of Canada has strongly recommended that only members under the age of 70 should attend the services. Those with vulnerable immune systems should not attend and there is to be no singing, choir, and all must wear masks. There is to be no socializing; we are far from pre-pandemic days of worship. The restrictions on worship at Grace, or any church, for that matter, make online worship a safer and more viable option at this time. We have made tentative arrangements with St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church to hold joint services, with each church preparing a service on alternate Sundays, starting with Grace United Church on Sunday, June 28."
