¹ By: Komitas - (Soghomon Soghomonian), September 26, 1869 – October 22, 1934. He was an Armenian Priest and a composer. He was arrested by the Turkish government on the night of April 24, 1915 and deported to the interior. He survived nearly four years in the killing fields. He later became a bishop and prelate of the Armenian Apostolic Church in southern France. He died in Marseilles.
