Minutes of the previous meeting held on November 3, 2022

Business arising from the minutes: Work on the Grace United Church Handbook is still ongoing.

Treasurer's Report:

The account balance of the Local Mission Fund as of December 31, 2022 was \$6,254.37.

At the next Official Board meeting Stewards will propose to add "Benevolent Fund" to the 2024 envelopes for local missions.

The Memorial Fund is administered by the Trustees.

Offerings for 2022 were up slightly from 2021.

Fund raising for 2022 was double that of 2021.

Mission and Service givings were up from 2021.

\$120,000 was transferred from Trustees during 2022.

We are looking at breaking the Trustee funds that are locked in.

As of December 31, 2021 the bank balance was \$16,235.

Vicki Leakey moved that this report be accepted. Seconded by Cliff Edwards. Carried.

Maintenance Committee Report: The cracks in the sidewalk have been brightly painted. They will be repaired in the warm weather.

A donation of \$1,000 was received for a new freezer to replace the one that quit working.

The first aid kit needs upgrading. A list of first aid procedures for emergencies should be drawn up. There are local experts that can help with this.

Reports on Fundraising and Community Outreach

Nunnys Bag was well received. Christina Kaya would like to do another show in the spring.

<u>A Fundscrip</u> group Christmas order was placed. During the year people are placing their own orders.

<u>Christmas Market</u> was a financial success raising approximately \$5,500 with over 200 people attending.

<u>Request for support</u>: no new requests. T.R. Leger has previously been informed that their request will be decided in the spring.

New Business

<u>Senior's Program at Grace</u> is being held in conjunction with the Gananoque Seniors Association, who has received a grant for programming until the end of March. Grace is one of the five sites where courses are being offered. Conversational French and pain management are the topics for the programs to be held at Grace. Each location will look after publicity for its own programming. Ways and Means Committee in the past has planned fund raising events. A new group has now come together, planned the Christmas Market, and is thinking ahead to other fundraisers such as a Mother's Day Tea to be held on Saturday May 13.

<u>Spring Concert:</u> There are several options for a spring concert. Paul Harding and Cliff Edwards would like to do a concert. Mary's Merry Minstrels have offered to do a gospel concert. Perhaps this would be best suited to a Sunday and even within the church service. Another option is HoozHear, a young group of musicians, who might encourage more young people to attend than other groups would. We need to be mindful of the cost of outside musicians when planning concerts.

<u>Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper</u> will be held on February 21. It will be prepared by the men of the church, with help from others for bussing the tables and clean up.

Youth Gay Pride Alliance Group monthly meetings are being held in the church auditorium.

They continue with monthly inspections.

Opening Prayer: Denise Wood opened the meeting with the Serenity Prayer.

Minutes of the previous meeting held on March 16, 2023

Linda Brooks moved that these minutes be accepted. Seconded by Cliff Edwards. Carried.

Business arising from the minutes:

<u>FundScrip:</u> Not that many individual orders are being placed. People are still having trouble placing their own orders despite information in the bulletin telling them who to contact for help. An announcement will be made during church service.

Rev. Harry and Marion Seeley Scholarship Fund. There will be a donation basket at the potluck on April 30th for this fund. We will bring this up at the Official Board meeting on April 30th.

<u>Turkey dinner</u> will be held on Thursday October 5 at the Curling Club. It will be both eat-in and take out. Our cost is \$12.00 and we will charge \$18.00. Curling Club staff will do all the preparation and serving. We will be gathering items for a silent auction at the dinner.

<u>Mary's Merry Minstrels Concert</u> is confirmed for Saturday May 13th at 7:00 pm. Admission by donation. There are posters to put up around Gananoque.

Father's Day Cold plate lunch in June will be put on hold. Father's Day might not be the best Sunday for the lunch. We will decide if this is feasible after seeing the turnout for the potluck on April 30th. Pies and RibFest: The Lions and Rotary Clubs have asked if we would be willing to sell pies again this year. They have offered to set up the tent and transport the pies to the park. The pie makers decided to sell whole baked pies (not slices) and only on the Saturday from 11:00 am – 6:00 pm. There will be a handout for people to pick up advertising our pies and noting that frozen pies are available year-round. There will also be a sandwich board outside the church that day informing people that they can pick up frozen pies inside.

<u>Seniors classes</u> will continue in Grace Church with the continuation of MELT Exercise and French classes. These classes are free to those who had paid for a Seniors Association membership (\$35,00). <u>Upcoming concerts</u>: Cliff Edwards has been working on finalizing the concert schedule. To date: *HoozHear Concert* will be before mid- June, the date to be finalized. Tickets will be \$10.00 per person or \$20.00 per family.

Moved by Christina Gordon that we pay HoozHear a \$200 honorarium for their concert. Seconded by Linda Brooks. Carried.

Tower of Song, featuring the music of Leonard Cohen, on September 21, Cohen's birthday. *Turpin's Trail* in October. Cliff will see if/when they are available.

Bob Burtch Bluegrass/Country on November 25. Since the cost for this band at \$1,200 is much higher than any other concert, we will look for sponsors to cover the cost.

Christmas Show in December with Cliff Edwards, Shari Shenton, Paul Harding, and possibly one other. Denise Wood will email Paul to arrange a date and other details.

Financial Statement: 2023 year to date offerings were up over \$5,000 from the previous year. Operating expenses for the first 3 months of 2023 were down slightly from the previous year. During March an additional \$20,000 was transferred from Trustees for a total of \$40,000 thus far in 2023.

Bank balance as of March 31, 2023 was \$18,309.

Vicki Leakey moved that this report be accepted. Seconded by Linda Brooks. Carried.

T.R. Leger Bursary:

Moved by Shirley Clark that we donate a \$200 bursary to a T.R. Leger student who is continuing their education in a trades program. Seconded by Vicki Leakey. Carried.

Maintenance: The contract has not yet been received from Cogeco for the placement of antennas on the church steeple tower.

The church kitchen received a good report when inspected by the Health Unit. However, there was still evidence of mice. New soap dispensers have been installed by the hand washing sink. The Health Unit will do another inspection in 6 months.

New Business:

<u>Vacation Bible School:</u> We need to revisit the idea of a Vacation Bible School. It would be a lot of work not knowing how many volunteers would be available. It would have to be full day since it would be too hard for parents to arrange babysitting for the other half of the day.

<u>Communication at Official Board Meetings:</u> The Official Board is the governing body of the church and policies are approved here. All committees and individuals should feel free to bring ideas/questions to be discussed at the Official Board. An example for Stewards is that Session confirms requests for the use of the church facilities and sets the rates. However, Stewards are in control of finances. So perhaps Stewards should set the rental rates.

<u>Beacon Bags</u>: Denise Wood told us about a guest speaker at a recent UCW EOOR meeting. The topic was human trafficking. It happens much more than we realize and even in towns like Gananoque. Beacon bags are bags filled with personal items given to those getting out of trafficking.
